DAY 1: (MT, L, D) GOLD COAST

Monday 18th November 2024

This morning, we begin our journey North making our way towards the Sunshine Coast of Queensland. Not only is the Sunshine Coast known for its stunning coast line and beaches, it also showcases some of the most beautiful rainforests and villages to the West, which we will explore as we make our way across the Blackall Ranges and in to the Hinterland.

Our first stop this morning will be for a Devonshire tea at **Eungai Creek Buffalo Farm**, a working farm that produces a variety of delicious cheese, gelato, yoghurt and other buffalo products in the Nambucca Valley. Opportunity to purchase their products will also be available. Back on the road, we continue on following the Clarence River, stopping for lunch at the historic **Harwood Hotel**. Our day of travel ends on the Gold Coast, where we will retire in our beautiful accommodation at the **Royal Pines RACV Resort**.

DAY 2: (B, L, D) BRIBIE ISLAND to CALOUNDRA

Tuesday 19th November 2024

This morning, wake to a beautiful buffet breakfast by the resort pool before checking out and continuing our journey north hugging the coastline. This morning we head to Bribie Island for the day, the smallest and most northerly of three major sand islands forming the coastline sheltering the northern part of Moreton Bay. **Bribie Island** is a hidden gem connected to the mainland by a convenient bridge. It is also known as the **Pumicestone Passage.** This shallow estuary nestled between the mainland of Queensland and Bribie Island is approximately 35 kilometres long. It receives inflows from numerous small creeks and is subject to tidal flushing starting from Deception Bay, resulting in a slow net northern movement of water. The area contains a range of habitats including mangroves, saltmarshes, sand and mudflats, seagrass beds and coastal dunes. In the afternoon, we will check in to our accommodation at the Oaks Caloundra where we will spend the next 4 nights. This will be the perfect location to base ourselves for our next few days of touring.

DAY 3: (B, D) EUMUNDI, NOOSA & GINGER

The Original Eumundi Markets is the biggest and the best artisan market in Australia and has been operating since 1979. Located in the heart of the historic town of Eumundi, The Original Eumundi Markets started with only three market stalls and eight customers. This simple dream quickly grew to 203 stalls and 260,000 visitors by 1990. Now, the Eumundi Markets welcomes over 1 million visitors each year!

Plenty of time can be had at the markets before we make our way to Noosa, where you can continue your browsing and relaxed holiday vibe. Pop in your swimmers and towel in case you want to jump in the surf at Noosa's main beach?

Our final destination today, is to Yandina, where we will visit the Ginger Factory. On a guided tour we will learn about the factory processing before joining a train ride through the property. Of course there will be some samples to taste along the way.
